

Environmental & Sustainability Policy

Policy Statement

Pelican Engineering CO (Sales) Ltd aims to promote the protection and enhancement of the environment whilst we conduct operations, provide services and sales. Our aim is to educate staff in environmental issues and to contribute, as responsible members of society, to a reduction in waste and carbon usage and to provide a safe, sustainable and pleasant environment in which to learn and work. The underpinning ethos of the company is to:

- Ensure that we are compliant with environmental legislation
- Recognise that we are both a consumer and provider of services and respond appropriately to this; to review our environmental impact at regular intervals under our ISO14001 impact and aspect register
- Recognise our areas for development and implement improvements
- To use resources carefully which in turn will help to reduce operating costs

1. ENVIRONMENTAL BEST PRACTICE

We will introduce a waste management system to:

- Segregate different types of waste wherever possible to facilitate the recycling of materials wherever possible and reduce the amount of waste being disposed of in landfill sites
- Meet legislative requirements and ensure that all waste is disposed of legally e.g. in accordance with WEEE requirements
- Reduce waste, hazardous substances and harmful emissions
- Actively avoid risk of pollution

We will introduce energy and resource conservation measures to promote:

- A reduction in the amount of energy used and those used are from a “**Renewable Energy Supply** – providing **Green Electricity**” demonstrating commitment to reducing our environmental impact.



- A healthy and comfortable temperature for all working areas

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- A reduction in the amount of water used
- A reduction in the amount of paper and card used
- A reduction in the amount of plastic used and promotion of reuse/recycle initiatives where possible

We will promote green methods of travel where possible to include:

- Check travel of company vans against fuel used to ensure travel is done in the most productive way
- Consideration of alternatives for travelling to meetings
- Improve and invest in technology so that staff can participate in meetings via online systems

Wherever practicable, Pelican Engineering will ensure that all building and construction work adheres to current environmental standards and energy conservation requirements.

2. MONITORING ARRANGEMENTS

- Targets will be set via ISO14001 to meet aspects of the policy and these will be monitored by the Risk Assessments, Audits and Problem and Improvement Register

3. ORGANISATION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

3.1 Employees
